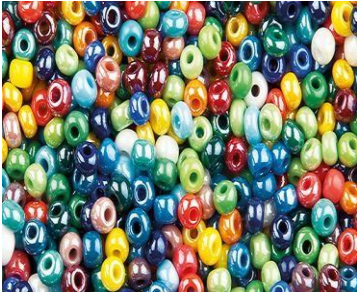

Beading by machine is a fun, but sometimes frustrating technique. Kathleen have done lots of research and discovered simple ways to attach beads to fabric by sewing machine. She plans to demonstrate each technique herself and then allow time for each student to try the technique for themselves on their own machine,

Since this technique is so specialized, she highly recommends that you bring the sewing machine you plan to use at home with you to class.

Kathleen will be supplying required kits (**\$7.00 each paid to Kathleen at the class**) for this class to ensure each student has the appropriate supplies to complete the technique in class. The kit will include beads, fibers, base fabric and stabilizer. Students will need to bring a few additional supplies.

Please be aware that this is a technique class: sample of the stitches will be made. No project will be made in this class.

Class Information: Bring a snack or lunch. Water will be provided.
